And here's a pro tip specifically for our friends in different areas: - If you're in central Riverside, focus on those side yards and rear sliders - Out in Jurupa Valley or Norco? Those long driveways need special attention - And for those of you in Corona or Moreno Valley dealing with HOA requirements, don't worry, we've got solutions for you too.

Before we wrap up, here's your holiday security action plan: 1. Get those cameras positioned correctly 2. Set up smart alerts (but make sure they won't spam you) 3. Enable two-way talk features 4. Have a solid monitoring plan 5. Don't forget backup power - because Murphy's Law loves a good holiday!
